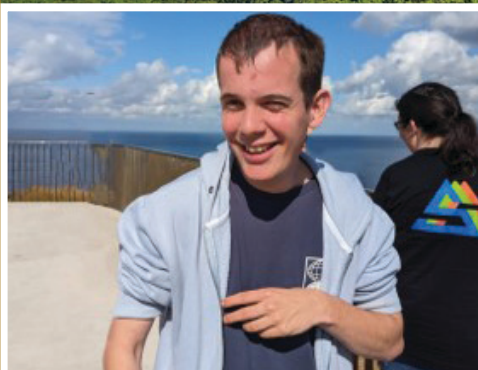
Gold Coast (Drive)

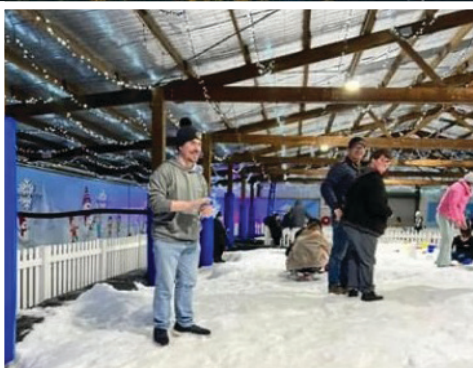
NSW Thermal Pools & Silo Tour

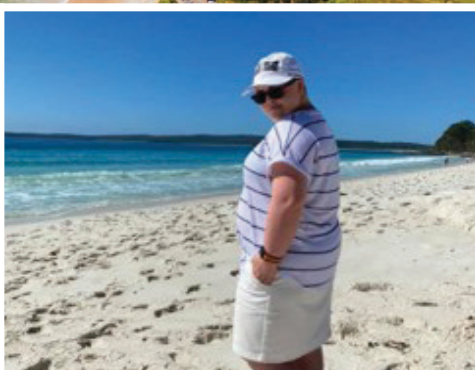
Canberra & Snow Experience

Bookings and Confirmation

To make a booking you will need to contact Summit Community Network to check availability, level of support required and suitability.

A Confirmation Invoice will be sent to you, stating when and how the deposit is to be paid. Once deposit has cleared in Summits account your spot is confirmed.

Cancellation

Cancellation fees apply if after confirmation has been confirmed by deposit and passenger cancels their trip. Notice of cancellation must be made in writing (email) to Summit Community Network.

Fees are as follows:

120 days or more	Full Refund

90 days or less	90% of total cost
